

Robert Langston studied at the Royal Academy of Music and Cambridge University, where he was Organ Scholar of Peterhouse. For many years he taught at the Royal Academy and was Organist and Director of Music at St Bride's, Fleet Street and later, at Lincoln's Inn Chapel in London. He has given organ recitals in Europe, the USA and Canada (three extended tours) and the Far East, as well as having worked as repetiteur and piano accompanist.

For the last 14 years, he has been living and working in Hong Kong, where he established his own music teaching studio, hosted a classical music radio show, worked as an actor on television and toured South East Asia, New Zealand, the Middle East and South Africa as a music examiner and competition adjudicator. He returned to the UK last December to be near family, ostensibly to retire but, addicted to music making, decided to continue his work as a freelance organist, pianist, teacher and accompanist.
